- Rejection of Him as king = rejection of God
- *Reveals man's heart
- Man rejects the Lord's King and wants to be his own king

- 3000 year old piece of literature King David
- Rejection of Him as king = rejection of God
 - Lord = Jehovah
 - Anointed One = God's Messiah
- Reveals man's heart
 - Chains, fetters
 - You will not tell us what to do! WE will decide!



Genesis 3 all over again

""You will not surely die," the serpent said to the woman. "For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."" (Genesis 3:4–5, NIV84)

This is the heart of man!



❖ Fast forward 1000 years – from David to Jesus' time

"You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our father David: " 'Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the Lord and against his **Anointed One.' Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate** met together with the Gentiles and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed." (Acts 4:25-27, NIV84)



- Apostles are clear- Psalm spoken by David is about Christ
- Lord = Jehovah = God the Father
- **❖** Anointed = Messiah = Christ
- You Jehovah You Jesus will not rule over us!
- Genesis 3 again!
- The heart of man!

❖ Fast forward ???? years – tribulation

2. Reaction v4-6

- Heart of Man
- I need to show you I am in control
- Very hard not to justify myself, prove you are wrong
- Jehovah is not like us
- He is in no hurry but He is in absolute authority

Do not be deceived by apparent 'inaction'



- Decree of Jehovah:
- ❖ Son Father
- When??? Christmas?????? Nativity??
- ❖ No!

""We tell you the good news: What God promised our fathers he has fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus. As it is written in the second Psalm: "You are my Son; today I have become your Father." (Acts 13:32–33, NIV84)

- God's King God's Messiah Christ
- Won the victory at His death & Resurrection

"And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death even death on a cross! Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Philippians 2:8-11, NIV84)



God's promise fulfilled

4. Response v10-12

- To Jehovah
 - **❖Serve Him with fear = submit to Him and give Him his place (opposite of Gen 3!)**
 - Rejoice with trembling = worship
- To the Son Messiah Christ
 - Kiss show reverence, submit, worship
