
Our Dilemma



Violent passengers on El Al flight from NY to TLV



Chaos and violence as El Al flight delayed

After a five-hour delay, an El Al flight from NY to Israel lands in Athens to avoid desecrating Shabbat; in response, passengers clash with crewmembers; 'young flight attendants were hit and verbally attacked by ultra-Orthodox passengers'; El Al says it will file a complaint with the police.

- 4. 6 expansions of the law even tougher 5:21-48
 - a. Just be angry & curse worse than murder!

It Gets Worse



- 1. 'Jesus fulfilled the law' so we ignore it but what about v19 & 20 ??
- 2. Do we toss out the 10 commandments? No! But break Sabbath (not Sunday)
- 3. Quote OT verses about sexual morality, bad to get tattoos, but we love our pork chops



4. The Law is honoured in the New Testament "So then, the law is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous and good." (Romans 7:12, NIV84)



- 4. The Law is honoured in the New Testament "We know that the law is spiritual; ..." (Romans 7:14, NIV84)
- "For in my inner being I delight in God's law;" (Romans 7:22, NIV84)



- 4. The Law is honoured in the New Testament "Do we, then, nullify the law by this faith? Not at all! Rather, we uphold the law." (Romans 3:31, NIV84)
- "We know that the law is good if one uses it properly." (1 Timothy 1:8, NIV84)



4. The Law is honoured in the New Testament "This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people." (Hebrews 8:10, NIV84)

"For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12, NIV84)




4. The Law is honoured in the New Testament

All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."


