Backdrop to Jesus' Words

- Incredible miracle, healed man who was born blind
- Religious rulers have reviled and rejected:
 - the miracle
 - the man who was healed
 - Jesus
- Jesus is responding to the false oppressive leaders



- Contrasts himself with the enemy
- Thieves & Robbers
 - Oppressive religious leaders
 - False Messiahs false deliverers
 - False religion
 - False empty gospel less 'Christianity'
 - Devil



- Contrasts himself with the enemy
- Thieves & Robbers
 - 1. Steal
 - 2. Kill (slaughter, butcher)
 - 3. Destroy



- The enemy blinds us with :
 - pain
 - anger
 - greed
 - overabundance
 - focusing on our circumstances



- The enemy false religion, devil, sin, are the source of all:
 - Disease
 - War
 - Suffering
 - Brokenness
 - Heartache
 - Loneliness
 - Loss



• Are my current circumstances the determiner of how I view this time of year?

The enemy is the master of circumstances



- 1. He was sent by the Father cradle v 36
- 2. He lays down and takes up His life cross v 17-18
- 3. Through Him we are:
 - ✓ Saved, eternal salvation v 9, 28
 - ✓ Secure never perish v 28 (destroyed v 10) safe v 28
 - ✓ Needs are met v 9 (physical, emotional, spiritual)
 - ✓ Life is abundant v 10 (part now full in eternity)
 - ✓ Intimate relationship with his followers v 3-5, 14-15

<u>Or</u>

- Is Christ The Door, The Shepherd (eternity) the determiner of how I view this time of year?
- Jesus is the master of eternity



- Spirit of Truth Church last week

Jesus: I have come to bring total deliverance!

- Circumstances are not the determiner of the follower of Jesus
 - Yes we may be in plenty
 - We may be in a good place
 - We may be in great pain, deeply grieved
