

Jesus: The Submissive King! 2 Kings 9:1-10;10:28-31 Pew Bible pg. 266

- Anointed King
 - God calls him to lead God's people 9:6
 - God commands him deal with sin!
 - Strike the whole house of Ahab 9:8
 - Also Ahab's wicked wife Jezebel 9:10



- Seems to be zealous
 - Does as commanded
 - Claims to be zealous for the Lord 10:16

"Jehu said, "Come with me and see my zeal for the LORD." Then he had him ride along in his chariot." (2 Kings 10:16, NIV84)



- Seems to be zealous
 - Does as commanded
 - Claims to be zealous for the Lord 10:16
 - Seems to go above and beyond 10:28

"So Jehu destroyed Baal worship in Israel." (2 Kings 10:28, NIV84)



God rewards his service 10:30

"The LORD said to Jehu, "Because you have done well in accomplishing what is right in my eyes and have done to the house of Ahab all I had in mind to do, your descendants will sit on the throne of Israel to the fourth generation.""

(2 Kings 10:30, NIV84)

- Was it God's will or his???





Was it God's will or his???

- *He 'did' for God but not God's way.
- 1. Murders Ahaziah King of Judah (his wife is Athaliah daughter of Ahab and Jezebel) 9:27
- 2. Murders Ahab's chief men, friends, priests 10:11
- 3. Murders Ahaziah's relatives 10:14



Was it God's will or his??? ***He** 'did' for God but not God's way.

"Then the LORD said to Hosea, "Call him Jezreel, because I will soon punish the house of Jehu for the massacre at Jezreel,..." (Hosea 1:4–5, NIV84)



Was it God's will or his???

- *He 'did' for God but not God's way.
- He worshipped God in name only but not according to God's will.

"However, he did not turn away from the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, which he had caused Israel to commit—the worship of the golden calves at Bethel and Dan." (2 Kings 10:29, NIV84)



Was it God's will or his???

- *He 'did' for God but not God's way.
- He worshipped God in name only but not according to God's will.
- He did not obey with all his heart
- "Yet Jehu was not careful to keep the law of the LORD, the God of Israel, with all his heart. He did not turn away from the sins of Jeroboam, which he had caused Israel to commit." (2 Kings 10:31, NIV84)



Was it God's will or his???

- He was what the NT calls doubled minded
- ❖He does things for God but it is ultimately about what he wants – his will – not God's



"Such a person is doubleminded and unstable in all they do." (James 1:8, NIV)

"Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do." (James 1:8, NLT)






3. Christ – The Submissive King


