#### 1. The Dilemma

"I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. I love God's law with all my heart. But there is another power within me that is at war with my mind. This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death?" (Romans 7:21-24, NLT)



#### 1. The Dilemma

Is your life <u>dominated</u> by fear, defeat, condemnation? (the question is <u>not</u> do you sin & fail!)

- If I say 'yes', what does the answer tell me?
- 1. I am not a born again believer...... OR
- 2. I am a believer but not living in the Spirit.



#### 1. The Dilemma

"Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin. So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death." (Romans 7:25–8:2, NLT)



#### 2. The Person

- The focus of chapter 8 is a person the Holy Spirit
  - Spirit of Life v 2, 6
  - Spirit of God v 9
  - Spirit of Christ v 9
  - Christ in you v 10
- Romans chapters 1-7 Spirit appears 5x
- Romans Chapters 9-16 Spirit appears 8x
- ❖ Romans 8:1-17 Spirit appears 17x!
- ❖ Romans 8:1-39 Spirit appears 21x!



#### 2. The Person

Is there any hunger to be different, to get rid of the ways of the world, sin, defeat, condemnation, fear ...? For the true follower of Jesus, the answer is found in a person, the power of the Holy Spirit – Christ in us!

'Mind set on' = thought, purpose, will, the thoughtful planning, the seat of your mental and spiritual activity

"So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace." (Romans 8:6, NLT)

"Obsession with self in these matters is a dead end; attention to God leads us out into the open, into a spacious, free life." (Romans 8:6, The Message)

- "And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ." (1 Corinthians 3:1, NASB95)
- "What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you?" (James 4:1, NIV84)
