












2's & 3's Large Room, Storage, Sound System, Bathroom

So what does it mean for us?


Gym not available from March 1 –
 September 2019


 No gym rentals during that time; however, auditorium can still be rented Other areas of the building may be closed during renovation





Receipts: Sept 2018 YTD Actual vs. Full Year Budget




Total Full Year Budget: \$794,000

2018 Year End

General Fund

Due to increased offering participation, September was our first deficit balance this year!

Building Fund

Typically 65-75% comes in October-December

- Down Payment concerns Start now!
- Potential Savings:
 - \$250,000 = \$145,000 savings
 - \$500,000 = \$288,000 savings

Vision -

Phase 3

Proposed Savings with loan program

- 3% Loan versus 5% mortgage
 - = \$6180 on every \$100,000 every 5 yrs.

Response - \$94,000

- 0% Loan versus 5% mortgage
 - = \$22,805 on every \$100,000 every 5 yrs.

Response - \$162,000

Excellent way of helping – reduces interest cost
