Psalm 33:4-19



always speaks the truth

⁴ For the word of the LORD is right and true; he is faithful in all he does.



sticks by us - He is loyal.

⁵ The LORD loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of his unfailing love.



- is all powerful.
 - ⁶ By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth.
 - ⁷ He gathers the waters of the sea into jars^[a]; he puts the deep into storehouses.
 - ⁸ Let all the earth fear the LORD; let all the people of the world revere him.
 - ⁹ For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm.



- is working out His plan.
 - ¹⁰ The LORD foils the plans of the nations; he thwarts the purposes of the peoples.
 - ¹¹ But the plans of the LORD stand firm forever, the purposes of his heart through all generations.
 - ¹² Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people he chose for his inheritance.



- sees clearly and continually.
 - ¹³ From heaven the LORD looks down and sees all mankind;
 - 14 from his dwelling place he watches all who live on earth—
 - ¹⁵ he who forms the hearts of all, who considers everything they do.



- loves and is able to help.
 - ¹⁶ No king is saved by the size of his army; no warrior escapes by his great strength.
 - ¹⁷ A horse is a vain hope for deliverance; despite all its great strength it cannot save.
 - ¹⁸ But the eyes of the LORD are on those who fear him, on those whose hope is in his unfailing love,
 - ¹⁹ to deliver them from death and keep them alive in famine.



God Calls Us to Actively Wait





Patient – God is our help and shield.

²⁰ We wait in hope for the LORD; he is our help and our shield.



Buoyant – our hearts rejoice in Him (not circumstances).

²¹ In him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in his holy name.



Informed – we trust in His Holy Name.

²¹ In him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in his holy name.



Focused – on God Himself and His mission.

²² May your unfailing love be with us, LORD, even as we put our hope in you.
