

God's sovereign choice (election) Romans 9



Flow of thought

1. Ignorance is *not* bliss! 10:1-4

 Israel was zealous but in ignorance – sought their own righteousness – not Christ's – the barrier is not God's election but man's religious self righteous rejection of God's righteousness in Christ alone

2. No Rules Allowed! 10:5-13

True righteousness is only by faith and confession of Jesus as Messiah. <u>All</u> who call upon the Lord are saved!

3. Five Precious Verbs 10:14-21

 Sent, Preached, Heard, Believed, Called God has done His part – Most of Israel (and most Gentiles) have rejected God repeatedly and have been hard hearted.











Rules demand obedience - we know we fail



 Faith does not require that you reach to heaven or the Abyss (thus it is nothing of yourself) – it is simply a conviction of heart and a confession with the mouth

Romans 10:9–13 (NIV84)

⁹ That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. ¹¹ As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." ¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, ¹³ for,

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
