#### Romans 1-11

- There are 523 <u>Indicatives</u> that is what we call action words. Facts. Most of these are simply declaring truth to us.
- There are only 13 <u>imperatives</u> that is what we call action words that command us to do something
- That means there averages barely 1 command per chapter!

#### Romans 12-16


- There are only 115. <u>Indicatives</u>
- There are 49 <u>imperatives!</u>
- That means there averages about 10 commands per chapter!

### 1.Step One: Offer Yourself

- "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." (Romans 12:1, NKJV)
- Does not say make yourself holy! Done Romans 1-11
- What do I actually own? What does God 'need'? My heart!
- "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship." (Romans 12:1, NIV84)
- True, complete worship, is the giving of myself, living out the gospel. Caring for the poor, integrity at work & school, honouring my parents, abstaining from immorality etc. etc.



### 1.Step One: Offer Yourself

"In view of God's acts of mercy it is entirely fitting that we commit ourselves without reservation to him. To teach that accepting the free gift of God's grace does not necessarily involve a moral obligation on our part is a heresy of gigantic proportions. The popular cliche "He is Lord of all or not Lord at all" is absolutely right. *Mounce, R. H.*
