Accurate Self-awareness

- Two types of self-awareness
 - 1. Internal self-awareness
 - How clearly we see ourselves: values passions, fit to environment, strengths, weaknesses, impact on others etc.
 - 2. External self-awareness
 - Knowing how others view us in the same categories above



Accurate Self-awareness

1. Internal self-awareness

- When accurate
 - Higher job satisfaction, relationship satisfaction, personal social control, happiness
- When inaccurate
 - Anxiety, stress, depression

2. External self-awareness

- When accurate
 - Able to show empathy, able to take others perspectives,
 - People have better relationships with you, see you as more effective
- When inaccurate
 - Opposite of above I can't show empathy, don't see though others eyes
 - Broken or weaker relationships, frustration in tasks



Accurate Self-awareness

"We've found that even though most people believe they are self-aware, self-awareness is a truly rare quality: We estimate that only 10%-15% of the people we studied actually fit the criteria."

- How well do we understand our spiritual gift(s)? (given at salvation)
- How well do we understand how others around us see us?








15 aponeurosis of external abdominal oblique m.




