









Add extension to the back of the old building


Renovate the "old" part of the building


two floors

Lower = 3,954Upper = 2,310






Why Expansion?


- Larger Children's Classrooms including P2P friendly design
- People Flow accessible 2nd entrance
- Family Connection Zone Sunday morning
- Community connection Children play area and café
- Bright, Open mid-week meeting area



Renovations to old building


- Overall growth is putting pressure on old room sizes, washrooms, WBC Kids curriculum, etc.
- KidZone recently 37 children on Tuesday evening (up from 20 last year)
- WBC Kids Grades 1-6 explosive growth in the next 3-4 years TWO large meeting areas needed. Grades 1-3 and 4-6.
- Nursery room size and P2P considerations





Renovations to newer building

- Open Connection Area "Chapters" feel Integrated Library, Lounge and Meeting area
- Jr. Youth and Quench Tuesday/Friday night hangout zone
 - 50+ people
- Young parents/grandparents w/children Sunday mornings (separate yet connected to the main service – TV screens)
- Overflow from main auditorium
- Connection zone between services seating



Downstairs – Newer Building

Other needs met

- Flexible multifunctional space
- P2P 2 secure zones older & younger children
- More admin office space
- Improved accessibility in the building with accessible exits; elevator
- More washrooms in Children's ministry rooms(P2P)
- More storage


