


Baptism

- 1. In the NT era
 - a. Believed and baptised at the same time
 - b. No such thing as to believe and not get baptised
- 2. Paul is reminding the Roman believers of their water baptism
- 3. Paul is teaching what the symbol of baptism representedwhat happened to them spiritually when they believed by faith in Christ – central focus is not water baptism but spiritual baptism



Baptised into Christ




"For we were all baptized by one Spirit into one body..."

 buried




Baptised into Christ's Resurrection v 1-10

V - 7 we will live






Baptised into Christ

11 So you also must <u>consider</u> yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.









The Central Purpose


Isn't this the whole Easter Story?


