Invitation

Invitation – "Come"

- Means someone's presence is desired
- Requires setting priorities
- Triggers a response



Qualification

Qualification – "All who are weary and heavyladen"

- Weary/toiling: exhaustion from doing stuff
- Heavy-laden/burdened: carrying a load



Qualification

- Context: Jesus was speaking to Jews
- Oppressive system of laws and sacrifices
 - Weary from religious requirements
 - Burdened by slavery to sin
- BC = Before the cross!
- Open invitation to a specific group

Salvation – "Rest for your souls"


- Hebrews 10:11+12 => sacrifice, once for all
- Ephesians 2:4-6 => we are seated with Christ





Invitation – "Take my yoke and learn from me"







Invitation

- A yoke would ensure that the two oxen would
 - Stay close and move in the same direction
 - Share the load and learn from each other
- Yoke was a common term
- Yoke is discipleship language



Discipleship

Teacher: Rabbi Apprentice: Disciple The Goal: To know what the teacher knows ... to live as the teacher lives



Qualification

Qualification of the yoke

- For I am gentle and humble in heart
- For <u>my</u> yoke is easy and <u>my</u> burden is light
