• Some gifts are valued more than others (specifically, tongues)

- There are many gifts (ch.12)
- They are to be used out of love for the body (ch. 13)
- Gifts, (specifically tongues) should be used in an orderly way so that the church is built up (ch. 14)

Holy Spirit gives the gifts so that the body is built up! (12:7, 14:1-4, 14:26, Ch. 13)

1 Co. 12: 12-21


Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free —and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many.

One Spirit. One Body.

- Bride w Christ as the bridegroom
- Temple w Christ as the cornerstone
- Body w Christ as the head









Now if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body.

And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body.

If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body.

Problem #1

My gift isn't needed

- I don't know where I fit
- Everybody is needed!







The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!" On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and the parts that we think are less honorable we treat with special honor. And the parts that are unpresentable are treated with special modesty, while our presentable parts need no special treatment.

But God has put the body together, giving greater honor to the parts that lacked it, so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored

- We as a body may be missing out on gifts of the Holy Spirit given for our benefit and good!
- Your gifts are needed by the church and you need the other gifts in the church
