#### 3. Confusion v9-16

#### 4. Commitment v17-22

"All this came down on us, and we've done nothing to deserve it. We never betrayed your Covenant:" (Psalm 44:17, The Message)





#### 4. Commitment v17-22

- ✓ All the Psalmist is saying is "Lord, we don't know of anything we have done that would break our fellowship"
- ✓ Not self righteousness
- √ A clean conscience!





4. Commitment v17-22

"Wouldn't God have figured this out? We can't hide things from him." (Psalm 44:21, The Message)





#### 4. Commitment v17-22

- ✓ A moment of reflection
- ✓ Even if in our pain
- ✓ Even if confused and hurting because of others pain
- ✓ Do I have a clean conscience?
  - √ Forgiven in Christ- Salvation
  - ✓ A clean daily slate- Sanctification

- ✓ Now the verse Paul quoted in Romans

"No, you decided to make us martyrs, lambs assigned for sacrifice each day." (Psalm 44:22, The Message)

- ✓ The mountain is moved, the <u>self</u> is set aside!

#### 4. Commitment v17-22

- √ The mountain is moved, the <u>self</u> is set aside!
- √ Christlikeness! Your will Father!
