CS

- Jesus is God (vs. 11, John 10:30-33)
- He always was, He is, and always will be (Revelation 22:13)
- His is the Creator and ultimate authority (Colossians 1:15-20)
- He arrived with purpose (vs. 11)

Luke 7:1-10

"I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you" – Centurion (vs. 7)

The Centurion's Faith

(Luke 7: 1-10)



- -Jesus is amazed at his faith (vs. 9)
- -The centurion respects Jesus as God
 - -Does not want Jesus at his house (vs. 6-7)
 - -He recognizes Jesus power (vs. 8)

The Centurion's Faith

(Luke 7: 1-10)

-He is an important man, but he humbled himself before the Lord (vs. 7)

-He is a good man, but recognizes his need for the Lord (vs. 9)

What if He is the Lord?



- We should give him Lordship in our lives.
 - Obey Him (Luke 6:46)
 - Ask things of Him (Luke 7:1-10)
 - Worship Him (Psalm 100)
 - In humility, bring Him into our decision making (Psalm 37)
