CHRISTMAS

- A beautiful illustration of the interaction between heaven and earth, between the super-natural and the natural.
- 1. A natural young women visited by a super-natural being, an angel, telling about another super-natural being, the Holy Spirit, and His involvement in her pregnancy
- 2. A natural man, Joseph, warned by a super-natural angel
- 3. Jesus, THE super-natural becoming natural
- 4. The shepherds, natural men, informed by super-natural angels.
- 5. And now the natural Magi led by a super-natural sign, a star.







The term "Magi" is ultimately the Persian word "Magupati" that referred to a special class of priests in the Persian empire. Who were the Magi? They were the professors and philosophers of their day. They were brilliant and highly educated scholars who were trained in medicine, history, religion, prophecy and astronomy. They were also trained in what we would call astrology. There is a difference between astronomy and astrology.







"The Star"

The interaction between heaven and earth.

The star-whatever it was-would make perfect sense to them and would in fact perfectly fit what they already believed. You might say that if God wanted to get a message to these pagan priests, He picked the perfect way. What was "His star in the east?" What did they see and how did they know it was "His star" and how did they connect it with Israel?



Daniel

We know that the Jews and Persians had intermingled for at least 500 years. It seems that the Magi considered Daniel as one of their own.

Daniel 2:48 "Then the king promoted Daniel and gave him many great gifts; and he made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief administrator over all the wise men (the magi) of Babylon."



Did they have the Jewish scriptures and know Numbers 24:17, the prophecy of Balaam?

"I see Him, but not now;
I behold Him, but not near;
A Star shall come out of Jacob;
A Scepter shall rise out of Israel,
And batter the brow of Moab,
And destroy all the sons of tumult."

And is it possible that they had the book of Daniel?

Why did the Magi come?

The "Skygod" had somehow touched their hearts.

The Redemptive problem: SIN.

- 1. They came because of a universal craving to know God
- 2. They came because of the universal urge to worship
- 3. They came because of the universal consciousness of sin and the longing for forgiveness
- 4. They came because of the universal need for atonement, for a sacrifice



Christmas, God's provision for mankind's needs The Redemptive Solution: CHRIST

- 1. He came to give us the full knowledge of God
- 2. He came to be the only One worthy to be worshipped, King of kings, Lord of lords.
- 3. He came as the solution to our sinfulness, providing true forgiveness
- 4. He came to be the perfect sacrifice and make atonement for us. (Hebr.10:11-13)



Heb.10:11-13.

"And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool."

II. The reaction of king Herod

This is Herod the Great, who ruled from 37 B.C. to 4 B.C. Any study of Herod will immediately show that the man was a ruthless and paranoid tyrant. He killed two of his sons, and one of his wives. He was not Jewish. He was an Edomite, a descendant of Esau.

"Where is He who has been born King of the Jews?"
I, Herod, am king of the Jews.

Anger, hostility, the clashing of two thrones, two kingdoms.

The first martyrs for Christ.
