

Give thanks for that.





- III. To begin world evangelization.




I. Ex 25:8, "That I may dwell among them." 40:34, "And the glory of the Lord....."

THE HOLY SPIRIT CAME TO DWELL WITHIN US.

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; ("I will not leave you alone")I will come to you." John 14:16-18.

"Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?" 1Cor.6:19.

II. The birth of Christ's church

- The Holy Spirit living in the believers, the church.
- "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body." 1Cor.12:13.
- "Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?" 1Cor.3:16.
- "You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 1Peter 2:5.



THE IMPORTANCE OF THE CHURCH

God's dwelling place on earth.

"Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, ²⁰ having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, ²² in whom you also are being built together for a <u>dwelling place</u> of God in the Spirit." Eph.2:19-22.
